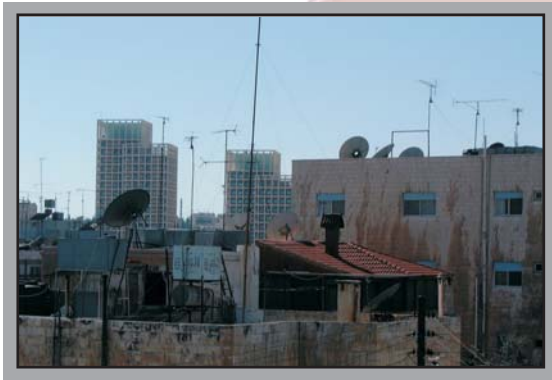

## What happened in 2003?

*People Who Met Jesus, Series 1*, is under license for translation into 11 languages to be used in the Philippines, Europe, The Middle East, North Africa, and Iceland.



*The World Of Jonathan Singh* programs were broadcast in Bangladesh via ATN Bangla TV, the Middle East via SAT-7 and MET, Tele 7 ABC Romania, and more than 40 local cable outlets.



*Communication Resources International (CRI)* was given the rights to overdub and broadcast *Winds of Adventure* programs in the country/s and languages of: Indonesia, Malaysia, Cambodia, Thailand, Vietnam, Laos, Myanmar, India, Pakistan and Bangladesh.



A radio antenna was purchased and shipped to Malawi for the National Church.

Media Training Extension Centers were established and training done in Capetown, South Africa and Sophia, Bulgaria.

## Radio's Reaching the Lost

An FM radio installation was completed in Kinshasa, DRC with the help of IMM. Through this radio station, the following story was received.

A bus driver had his radio tuned in with 22 passengers on the bus. As the bus arrived at it's stop, all the passengers stayed in their seats for the next 20 minutes because they wanted to hear the end of the radio message. According to the bus driver, several of the passengers were crying and when the call for salvation was given, several people raised their hands. This was God working through the radio ministry "La Borne", with Pastor Jacques Vernaud preaching on "You shall not steal".

This is just one way IMM partners with a local church to meet HIS mission with media.
