We have a new place to minister to Ladies. God has provided an apartment strategically located on the edge of the red light district. It will need a lot of work, painting, flooring, new kitchen, etc. It has a lot of space for meals, Bible studies, classes and just room for the girls to come and have a safe Christ filled environment to find refuge in. We are starting the process of renovating it and would like to finish the work and dedicate it in the first week of May with the women's team from Wisconsin. This is a place where we can minister to the girls in a God filled environment and not be distracted by the atmosphere in the red light district.

We are officially registered as an ASBL in Belgium!

This enables us to work with other governmental organizations as well as NATO and EU organizations, in this war on human trafficking. This status will also help us to apply for non-governmental status grants.

On March 8th, we passed out 100 white roses to the women in the red light district with the message that God loves them and they are valuable. The response was overwhelming, we could have easily given away 100 more.. In Eastern Europe this is a very important holiday and having someone recognize these ladies as having worth and value on this day was extremely important to them. Doors continue to open during these times that are not open to us at other times. Pray God orchestrates divine connections and protection for all the workers.



Baking Class

We had a professional pastry chef donate his time to teach classes to the girls on baking. They made éclairs and apple tarts. One of the ladies from Antwerp is getting married in April and the other ladies are using the skills from the class to bake for the wedding. This builds self confidence, teaches a skill and helps with the cost of the wedding. Next they will learn to bake bread and make little rolls, a favorite here in Europe.
